- Due date of June 1 each year

Responsive Grant Programs

- Due dates of February 1 and August 1 each year
- Fast Track up to \$12,500
- Midsize from \$12,500 to \$50,000
- 8 funding priorities, 2 under each Cornerstone

Applications are prioritized using the following criteria:

- Town's population is under 15,000 people
- Focus of mission and primary activities is in that small town in Oregon
- Not adjacent to an urban area
- Not inside of a metropolitan area
- Activities formally support or engage multiple agencies and businesses





Gold Beach Main Street (2024) - Working with citizens, community organizations, businesses, property owners and government entities to reinvigorate and increase community vitality, growth and prosperity.



Elkton Community Education Center (2023) - A rural community hub offering positive activities for all ages, healthcare access and resources, community events, and nutritious meals.



Main Street Cave Junction (2022) - Developing and sustaining a healthy, vibrant downtown that recognizes the community spirit, creates local opportunity, and inspires a high quality of life.



Greater Applegate Community Development
Corporation (2021) - Sustaining and enhancing
connections that promote the environmental, economic,
and social vitality of the Applegate Valley.
